MODERNIZATION AND EXTENSION OF TWO EXISTING MINERAL WOOL PRODUCTION LINES IN ROCKWOOL POLAND PLANT IN CIGACICE.

The contract comprised the construction of a kiln building of an area of almost 1500 m², a connector building of an area of more than 700 m² and an afterburner building of an area of almost 200 m² together with laying the foundations for a chimney of a volume of more than 500 m³. In addition, reinforcement and thermal insulation of the existing chimney was conducted, and foundations for new chimneys, silos, pipeline trestle and a ventilator were constructed. Moreover, a 2000 m² resource storing hall, a 560 m² resource dosage hall and an almost 1500 m² mill hall were constructed. The building housing the old kiln was refurbished, fitted with central heating, chilled water, process water, compressed air and basic lighting installations. The production building was also renovated, by adjusting it to the current technical and fire safety conditions, as well as adjusting the construction to enable the fitting of a new CIG1 technological line. The packaging line and transport buildings were also refurbished.
